

## SpokAnimal Barn Cat Program “Farm Livin’ is the Life for Me”

Thanks for offering to be a part of our cat overpopulation solution. The cat(s) you are taking today have been sterilized and vaccinated. Vaccination boosters are due in one year. After that, the rabies vaccinations are due every three years.

When you arrive home, we ask that you confine the cat(s) for a few days. Before you let them out of their carriers, put out the dry food we provided as well as some of the moist food. This will establish where they will be fed and a “home base” for them.

After the relaxation time of a few days, they may be given access to their new home. Volunteers at SpokAnimal will be calling within two weeks to see how the program is working for you and to see if you have any questions or problems we can address. There may be a second follow up about a month after the first call.

Sick cats may be returned to SpokAnimal.
